ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena 20m x 60m. Indoor warm-up area right next to competition arena. Arenas have dirt footing. Introductory and Training Level tests may be scheduled in small arena.

Camping on grounds

Any vehicle or trailer anywhere on the grounds that is occupied overnight will be charged \$18.50/night. No additional charge for hook-ups.

Food

Food will be available on grounds *during meal hours only*.

Stabling

Box stalls with full doors, first bedding included; additional bedding available for purchase. Please note any stabling requests on entry. **Stalls available after noon on Friday.**

Prize to first place; ribbons through sixth place.

I-5 north to 179th St./Battle Ground exit (#9). West on 179th. Left on 2nd Ave. at the “Equestrian Entrance” sign. Left into fairgrounds at Equestrian Entrance.

State on your entry if you are unable to ride on a specific day. Ride times will be posted at www.showoffice.org 5 days before show. Class scheduling may require changing the order of classes. Management reserves right to drop or combine classes, substitute judges or change classes to another day.
