ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Warm-up in outdoor arena, granite footing. Show arena in covered arena, sand footing. Lungeing in round pen only.

Directions

**From Jacksonville, travel East on California Street, that turns into South Stage Road And continue for 3.6 mi.

Turn right on Griffin Creek Road for .3 mi. then left on South Stage Road for 2.3 mi.

The stables are on the left side of the road 1 mile after crossing King's Highway.

**From Medford area, travel South on South Pacific Hwy (99) and turn right on South Stage road. Continue 1.1 mi. and the stables are on your right.

**From Ashland area, take I-5 freeway to the Phoenix exit (24). Turn left at signal, cross freeway then turn right at South Pacific Hwy(99) for 1.4mi, turn left onto South Stage Road for 1.1 mi, the stables are on your right.

South Stage Stables has White post and rail fencing along the front of property.

Cars park in small lot near road, electric gate opens automatically for trailer parking in barn area.

Dogs & Children

Dogs must be quiet and on a leash at all times. Children must be supervised.

AWARDS

Ribbons to fifth place. Prizes to first place.

CLASS DESCRIPTION

The Stakes Costume Class is a rail class, there is no dressage pattern.

The class may be split between riding entries (walk and trot only)

and entries in hand (at the walk only). The awards will be given to

top placings of both ridden and in hand entries. \$5 of the entry fee goes

to the stakes pot and the pot will be awarded 50/30/20 for first, second

and third placings respectively.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Will be sent by e-mail (telephone as second choice.). *IF you prefer to receive information by telephone, please specify, otherwise all information- times etc will be emailed.* It is ultimately the responsibility of the rider to get his/her times! As classes may be scheduled out of listed order, riders should be prepared to ride at any time.

VOLUNTEERING

Please fill out your entry form for any areas that you can help.

We expect all entries to offer 2 hours of help from themselves, a friend, or family Member, to help us run this show.

OTHER

You do not have to be a member of ODS to compete, however, a copy of ODS card REQUIRED for scores to count toward ODS awards, this show is a Qualifier for the ODS League Championships.

Horses not entered in the show are NOT allowed on the show grounds.

Riders who are unable to keep their horses under control may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit all entry fees. Be courteous and consider the safety of others at all times.

Coaching is allowed only from outside the warm-up arena.

Helmet or appropriate dressage hat and

boots are required, however half chaps are allowed. US Equestrian rules will be in effect.

Whips must be 43.3 inches or less in length.

Riders under 18 years of age MUST wear a helmet whenever mounted on any horse on the show grounds, even in costume class.

Remember that at League shows only informal show attire is required.

A short or long sleeved shirt, polo or turtle neck.(exception in the costume class, any modest top is acceptable.

Breeches, Jodhpurs, or casual pants (no jeans in dressage tests- exception in the costume class)

Long or short boots with a heel.

Half chaps permitted.

Competitor number **MUST** be worn on your horse all all times while on the show grounds.
