ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

Indoor competition arena, dirt improved with sand and sawdust. Covered warm-up arena, dirt footing. Intro - Training Level Test 2 ridden in 20m x 40m short arena; all other tests ridden in 20m x 60m standard arena.

Children & Pets

Yamhill County Fairgrounds allows leashed dogs on grounds. Small children must be under control.

Food

Concession on grounds.

RV Hookups/Camping

Hookups are \$15/day for hookups, make reservation and pay in full with entry, please.

Stabling

Horse or Tack Stall box stalls with full doors and initial bedding (shavings)

Saturday evening arrivals okay \$40

Prize to first place for classes of 3 or more; ribbons through fifth place.
