ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

All tests to be ridden in 20m x 60m sand arena. Schooling in competition arena available Friday evening prior to grooming. Warm up in outdoor sand arena. Lunging available in designated outdoor area.

Children & Pets

No Dogs please; and for safety, **no unattended children.**

Food

Concessions will be available on grounds.

Stabling

\$85/weekend or \$45/night. No haul ins. 12' x 12' box stalls, initial bedding provided. See "Where to Stay" on the next page for details about camping.

AWARDS

Prizes for first (classes with 3+ riders), ribbons first to sixth place.

The Arabian Horse Association (Region 4) will provide a rosette for the highest score earned by a registered Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian. Proof of registration must accompany entry form.

DIRECTIONS

The Equestrian Center at Brasada Ranch: From Highway 97 at the light next to the Bend Promenade (Mall) turn East onto Butler Market Road and proceed East. Follow Butler Market Road until you come to the very last stop sign at the "T." Turn left onto Hamhook Road, proceed for approximately 0.5 miles. Turn right onto NE Butler Market Road. Follow to the stop sign, turn left onto Powell Butte Highway and proceed for approximately 9 miles. At approximately 9 miles there is a sweeping left turn on Powell Butte Highway but you want to turn right from the right turn lane where the sign says SW Alfalfa Road. Proceed South on SW Alfalfa Road to the Brasada Ranch entrance which is approximately 2 miles on your left. There is a stonework sign at the entrance to Brasada Ranch.

ENTRIES

Each day is a separate show and requires a separate entry.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be sent by e-mail, or phoned if there's no email address. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would prefer to have ride times mailed to you. Classes may be split or combined at the show management's discretion.
