The Minutes of The Oregon Dressage Society Board Meeting held Aug. 20, 1983 at the Bamboo Terrace, Albany, Oregon.

The minutes of the July meeting read and approved.

The treasurer's report shows balance ending 8/20/83 as \$2,261.00. Membership Chairperson, Joyce Heinke, reported Chapter dues are payable and due as of September 1.
