

## **ODS Virtual Show Series High Point Winners Named**

ODS's first Virtual Dressage Show Series drew riders from Oregon, Washington and Idaho. They rode Dressage, Western Dressage and Western Dressage on a variety of breeds, from Andalusian to Warmblood. We are grateful to judges Kathy Casey, Sabine Ense, and Tracey Erway for their scores and insightful comments, which were hugely appreciated by the riders!

And now, our High Point award winners!

At INTRODUCTORY LEVEL, it was a very tight race between winner Chloe Aden on her American Warmblood, Mackenzie, with a 3-score average of 69.917%, and runner-up Zoe Forslund on her mother's Holsteiner, Lonesome Dove, with 69.854%. Both girls are from Sheridan, Oregon, where they ride with Anna Sanders.

At TRAINING LEVEL, Chloe and Mackenzie posted a 3-score average of 65.853% to take the JR/YR award. Keerthana Johnson-Lal of Warren, Oregon, and her mustang, Buster, placed second with 63.966%.

The high-scoring ADULT AMATEUR at TRAINING LEVEL, with a 3-score average of 71.839%, was Elizabeth Harris of Boise, Idaho, on her five-year-old Westfalen, Patriot AOF. Hannah Brown and her American Saddlebred, Warrior's Femme Fatale, placed second with 68.137%.

The SECOND LEVEL award will go to Mieke Mocke of Bend, riding her daughter's Percheron cross, Steel on Fire, to a 3-score average of 62.703%.

Mieke was joined by Jill Heavey on Tessa Welmoed, Lynda Krogh on Amore ISF, Ronda Fitton on Sir Gallahad, Rachele Gallinat on Peach, and Joyce Jue on Nick in putting together a 64.802% average across two shows and giving TEAM BEND the TEAM HIGH-POINT AWARD.
