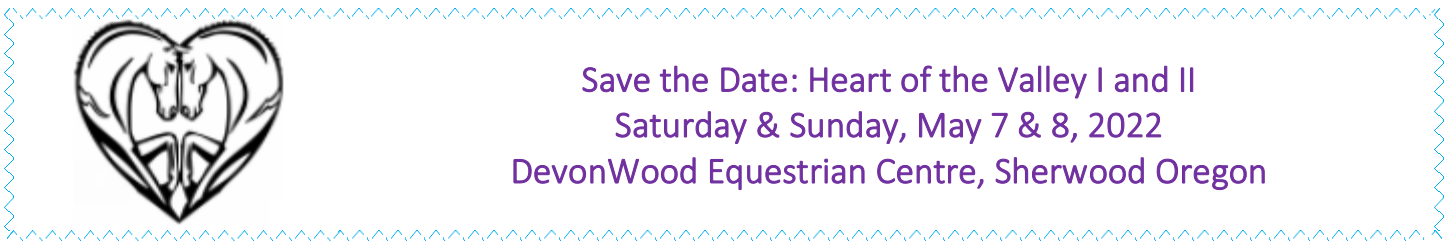

**Fees, Payments, & Refund Policy –**

- Paper Entries – make checks payable to MVC/ODS
- Post entry fee: \$5.00 additional per class.
- **Until Closing Date:** all fees refunded, less cancelation fee.
- **After closing date:** No Refunds
  - **COVID Exception** – Positive COVID test/exposure and/or symptoms refund less cancelation and class fees. (Class times will be refunded if classes can be filled by noon on Friday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.)

- In the event of classes being canceled due to severe weather, health risk, or other emergency, management's goal will be to refund as much as possible to competitors after covering expenses.

### Scheduling & Ride Times

- Provisional ride times will be posted on Fox Village at least five days prior to the show. Final ride times posted at least one day prior.
- Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed above.

### League Show Rules

- This is a league show. Tack and equipment in show ring and warm up will follow current USEF rules. [USEF DR121](#).

## Vaccinations & Coggins

- No horses will be permitted on grounds without a current Coggins within 12 months and proof of vaccinations (Equine Influenza Virus) & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) within 6 months prior to arriving on grounds.
  - **Proof of vaccination must be received at least 5 days prior to show. Horse entries will be canceled if proof is not received within 24 hours of arrival – no refunds.**
- Please consider using the USEF Vaccination Form to document your vaccinations. All documentation must specify the date and brand of vaccination given.
- If traveling from out of state a valid health certificate will also be required.
- Vaccinations required per USEF Rule GR845.

## Awards

- Ribbons to fifth place.
- Prizes to first place for classes with three or more.
- Classes may be combined or split.

## COVID Protocols

- Spectators are welcome!
- This is an Indoor Show; masks will be required at all times, regardless of vaccination status, while indoors (including breezeway to warm up and all upper barn areas), except while mounted in warm up or competition arenas.
- With the sharp rise in COVID cases and the Omicron variant, if mask rules are not followed, competitors may be scratched from their classes, no refunds. Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their “party.”
- We will adhere to USEF, USDF, state, and county guidelines.
- We will keep you updated if anything changes in rules or guidelines.

## ABOUT THE FACILITY

### Arena & Footing

- We will be running one competition arena. The area is an indoor competition arena, 20m x 60m, with warm-up, 20m x 40m, both Equi-Base footing (sand mixed with Geotek fabric over rubber matting)
- Lunging only allowed Terrace Arena or Lunging Area next to lower stabling. No lunging in warm-ups or round pens.

### Stabling

- **Three bales of bedding are provided. Additional bedding available for \$11 per bale.**
- No outside bedding allowed.
- Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors.
- Available Friday at noon through Sunday evening. Additional stabling must be arranged through DevonWood Equestrian Centre.
- Priority stabling in Upper Barns will be given to riders completing both days.

## **Parking & Camping Hookups**

- Rig must fit within space, both in length and width, to ensure a clear fire lane.
- Electrical service at the end of each stable row is available as a courtesy. Campers may run an extension cord during evening hours (6pm to 7am) but the cords must be stowed away during show hours.
- Please, out of courtesy for your neighbors, no generators.
- At this time of year, parking is not allowed in the grass field outside the gate. Free parking is allowed around the lower stabling area. If you plan to use power hook ups, please pay the hook up fee in advanced. Parking pass must be displayed in easy to see location for night checks. MVC will be charged for any hookups, and that charge will be passed on to you.

## **Children & Pets**

- **NO DOGS ALLOWED** on show grounds, except Medical Assistance Animals/Service Dogs, as permitted by law.
- Children must be supervised at all times.

## **Food**

- Concessions will most likely not be available on show grounds.

- Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Highway, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Road.
