It is difficult and expensive for league show riders from across the region to meet in one physical location, ODS is offering an opportunity for all ODS members to compete for League Show Year-End Finals.*


## **Check this Out!**

**Applying For League Horse/Rider Awards automatically puts you in the Championships if you have met the qualifications below!**

- Qualifying Dates are January 1, through December 31 of current show year
- The rider need not be the owner of the horse
- There is no fee to participate
- Riders must be a **CURRENT ODS MEMBER** in good standing **AT THE TIME THE SCORE WAS EARNED**
- Scores must be earned at ODS League approved competitions during the current show year
- Scores from USDF/USEF/ODS licensed shows and Practice shows do not count.
- Scores must be earned from current USDF tests

**You will automatically be entered in the League Championships:**

- IF you have a minimum of 4 tests, from two different judges, 2 at the highest level you are competing at
- Pas de Deux and Quadrille teams need only 2 scores from two shows and two different judges
- Placings for the Championships will be determined by an average of the 2 highest level tests and the highest 3rd test you submit

*To join the Century Club, the age of horse and rider must equal at least 100 years. Let the Dressage Foundation know ahead of time which show, test, and level you and your horse plan to do this ride.*

# ODS LEAGUE SHOW HORSE/RIDER AWARD

## Award Description:

A small brass plate engraved with the Rider and Horse's name, level of competition and number of 60% or better scores earned during the current show season.

A personalized wall plaque is available for purchase for mounting the plates.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Qualifying Dates are January 1 through December 31
- Scores must be earned at ODS League approved competitions during the show year
- Scores from USDF/USEF/ODS licensed shows and Practice shows do not count
- Scores earned from current USDF or USEF tests
- Riders must be a current member of ODS in good standing at the time the score was earned to be eligible
- The rider need not be the owner of the horse
- There is no fee to participate

## Instructions:

- Complete the application form for each level horse/rider combination for which you wish to obtain an award plate. A separate form will be need to be submitted for additional levels.  
NOTE: You can qualify for two consecutive levels with the same horse
- Complete the Rider Last and First names as you want to be engraved
- Enter Horse Name exactly as you wish to have it appear on the award plate
- Complete the mailing address section with the address you wish the award Plate to be mailed
- Please attach the front page of your qualifying tests that include the score and judge's signature
